ABOUT THE DARE PROGRAM

The DARE Fellowship Program takes Danish medical students to the San Francisco Bay Area for ten months to receive hands-on training in clinical research. Participants are closely mentored by internationally recognised clinical researchers at some of America's finest academic institutions.

The program is a partnership between the Lundbeck Foundation and Innovation Centre Denmark, based in Silicon Valley. This unique international partnership gives Danish medical students the opportunity to jumpstart their careers in medical research and bio-entrepreneurship.

QUALIFICATIONS

- Enrolled in a medical Masters degree course*
- Commit to ten months of clinical research in the San Francisco Bay Area
- Be motivated to engage in a social and ambitious research environment
- Desire to experience San Francisco and California

*Each medical faculty has its own specific requirements - we recommend checking these with the study administration.

- Fully-funded, 10-month fellowship in San Francisco, California, for five Danish medical students
- Comprehensive training in clinical research
- Training and collaboration with respected scientists from UCSF and Stanford University
- Highly supportive infrastructure, enabling students to accomplish their research and career goals
- Housing arrangement in San Francisco with fellow DARE students
